The following School Uniform policy has been drawn up following consultation with the Parent body during the school year 2013-2014 and in accordance with the requirements of Circular 63/2013.

The uniform is very important for the image of our school and it enforces your child's association with the school. We ask you to adhere strictly to the uniform as agreed and outlined below.

Girls:

Navy jumper/cardigan, Navy skirt/trousers, White shirt, Red tie, Shoes

Boys:

Navy jumper/cardigan, Navy trousers, White shirt, Red tie, Shoes

PE uniform:

Navy jumper, White t-shirt, Navy tracksuit, Runners

Please note: PE uniform may only be worn on PE related days, as instructed by the class teacher.

Footwear:

Flat sensible shoes must be worn. Runners are worn on PE days.

Markings to Avoid Loss:

All personal belongings are to be marked clearly. The Board of Management does not accept responsibility for children's property.

School Crest:

An optional sew/iron on school crest is available to purchase from the school.

Failure to adhere to the school uniform as outlined above will constitute a breach of the school rules and will result in sanctions for repeated offences. Uniforms will be checked regularly by school staff. All parents/guardians are asked to support the school uniform and ensure their child is correctly attired coming to school every day.
